



## Being a Good Person

- Step1: **THINK** ABOUT THE NEED OF OTHERS (food, safety, comfort, love, hope)  
 Step2: **IMAGINE** WHAT YOU CAN GIVE. (things, kind words, helping hand, money, time)  
 Step3: **DO** SOMETHING TO SHOW LOVE. (Give, look for better ways, follow-up)

Each one of us can be a good person everywhere we go. First example, at home, a good child washes dishes, cleans the house, waters the plants, does the laundry, hugs her mom, asks her if she's tired, and does her homework without her mom or dad telling her. Second example, at school or at church, if a friend is lonely what do we do? Let's think about how we can help. If a friend is lonely, we should go and cheer the friend up by asking what happened or by playing together. Third example, when an old man doesn't see very well, a good person would help him walk across the street, go up the stairs, and carry the groceries. God wants us to love everyone, for Jesus says in John 13:34-35, "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."






## Helping the Janitor

# THINK OF OTHER PEOPLE'S NEED



## HELPING MY SISTER



